Figure 1. Total Number of Clients Served by the Brown County CRC Since 2002

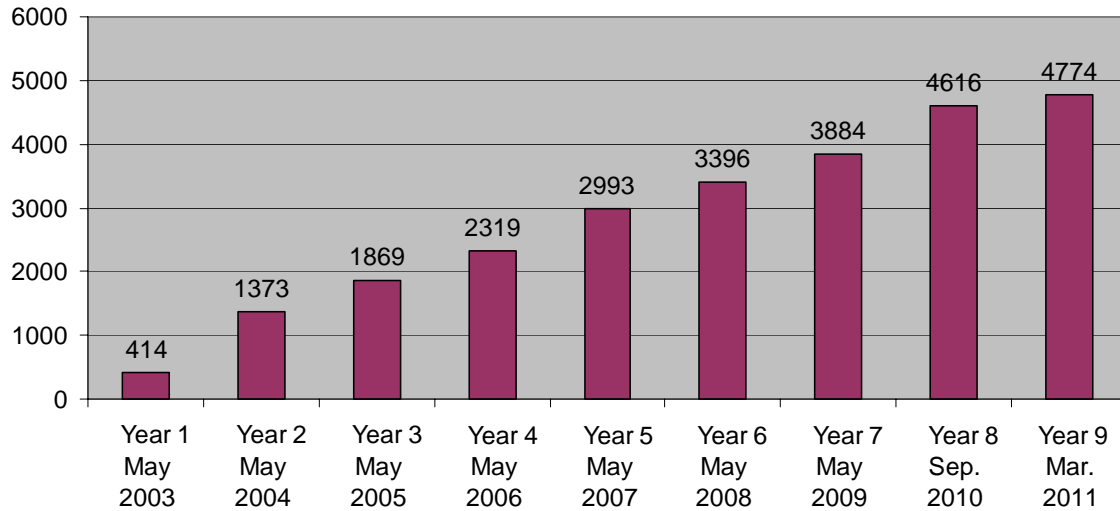

Figure 2. Cumulative Number of CRC Services Delivered Each Program Year

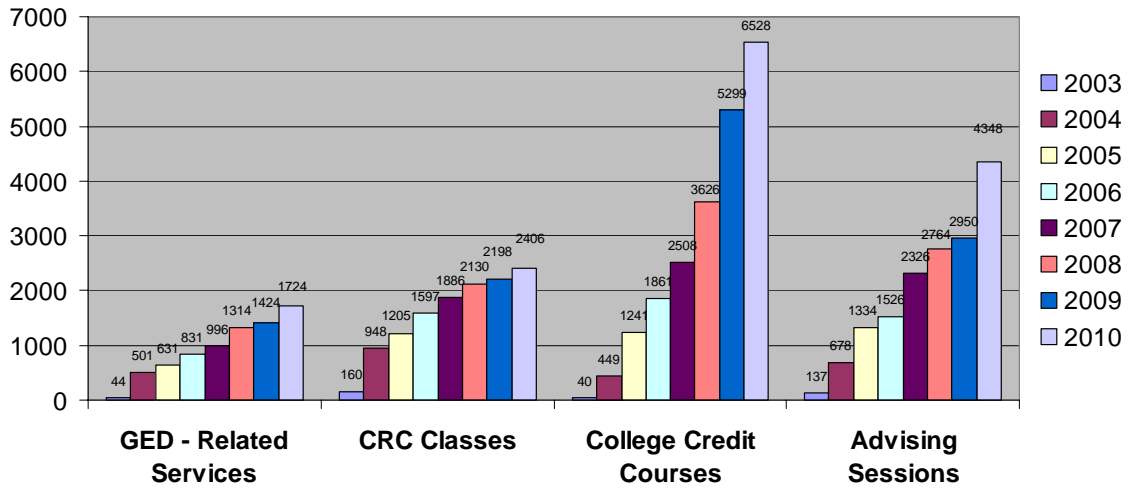


Figure 3. Percentage Use of CRC Services Since 2002

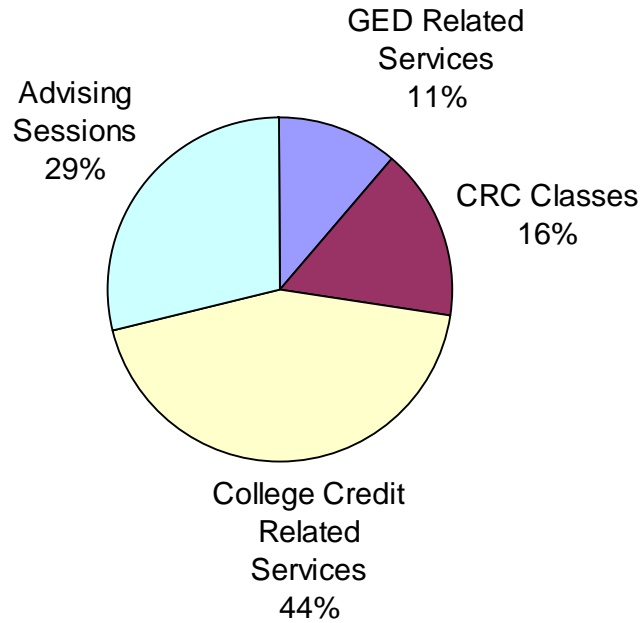


Figure 4. Number of College Courses Conducted at the CRC Each Semester Since Fall 2002

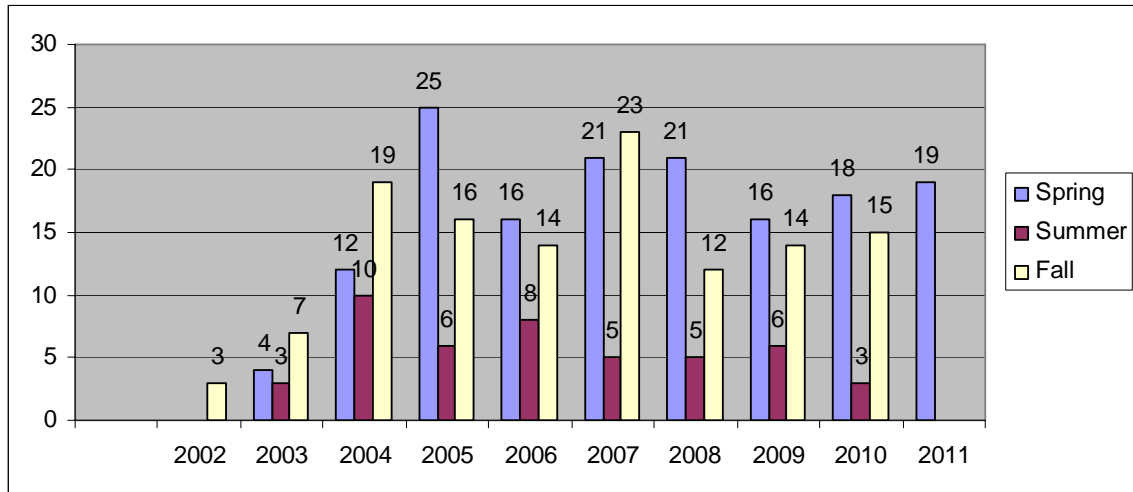

Figure 5. Course Completion Rates for CRC and Ivy Tech Columbus (2007-2010)

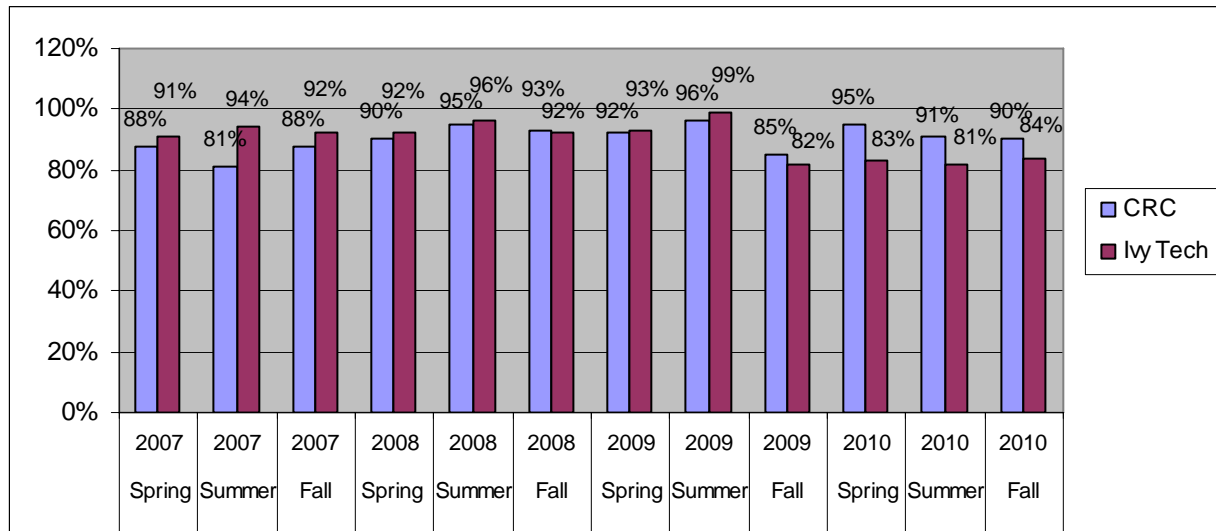


Figure 6. Number of GED Tests Attempted and/or Passed By Year

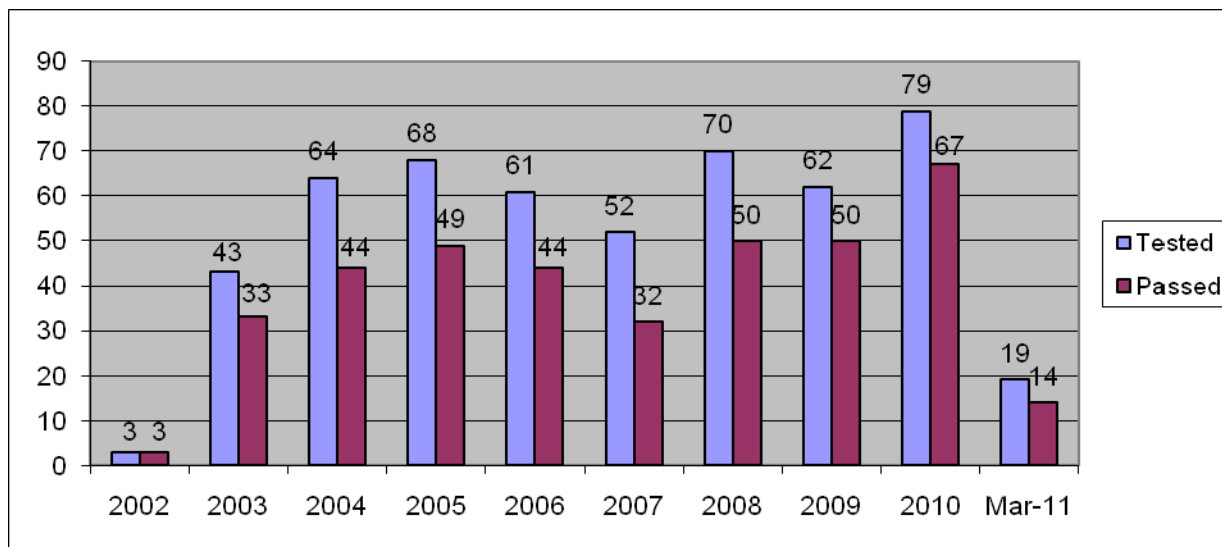


Figure 7. Cumulative Number of CRC Clients Taking the GED Tests By Year
