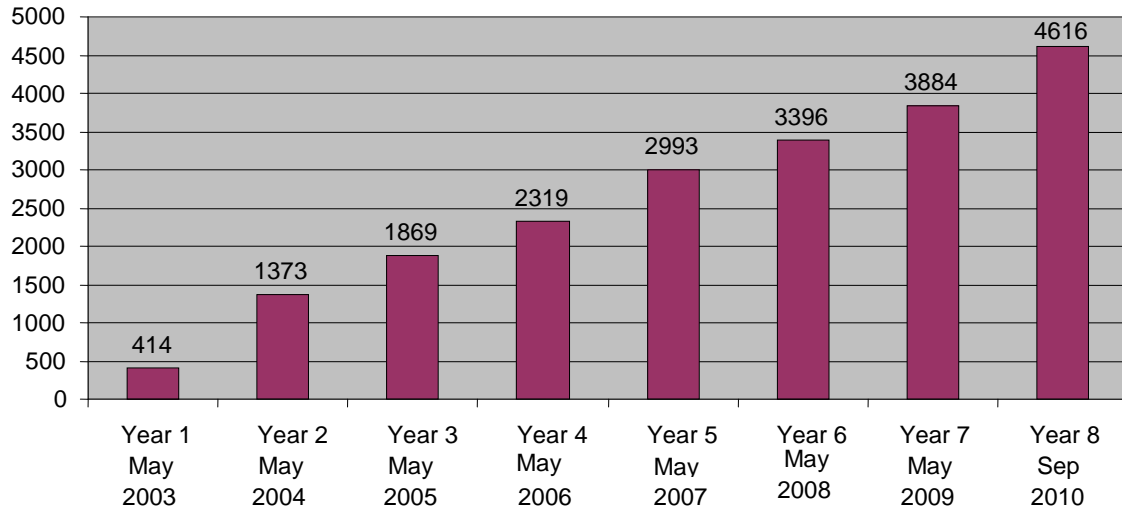

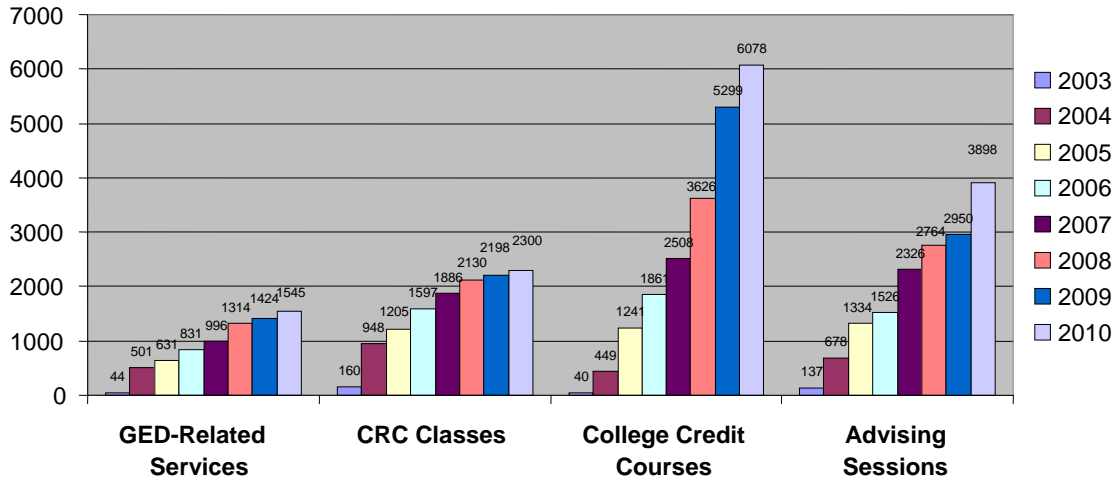

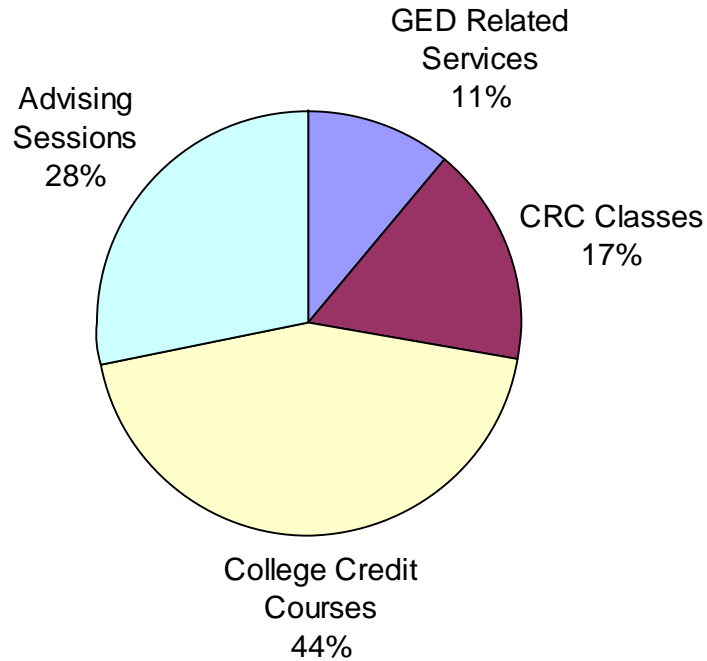

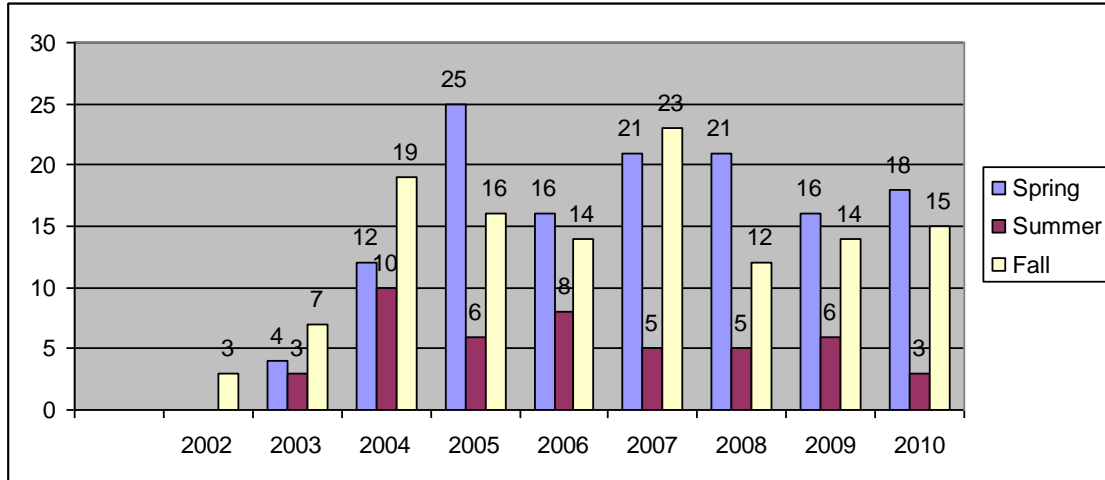
**Figure 2. Cumulative Number of CRC Services Delivered Each Program Year**

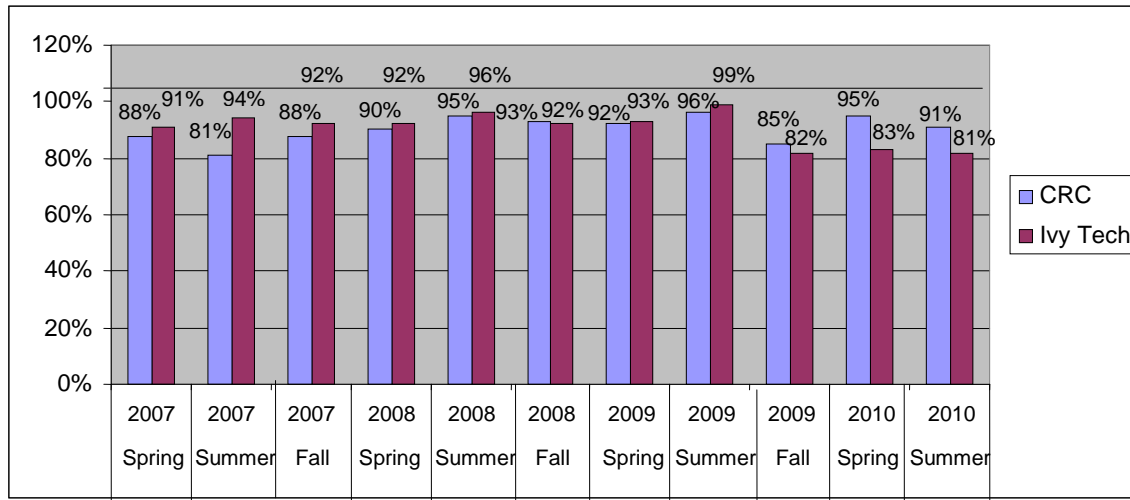

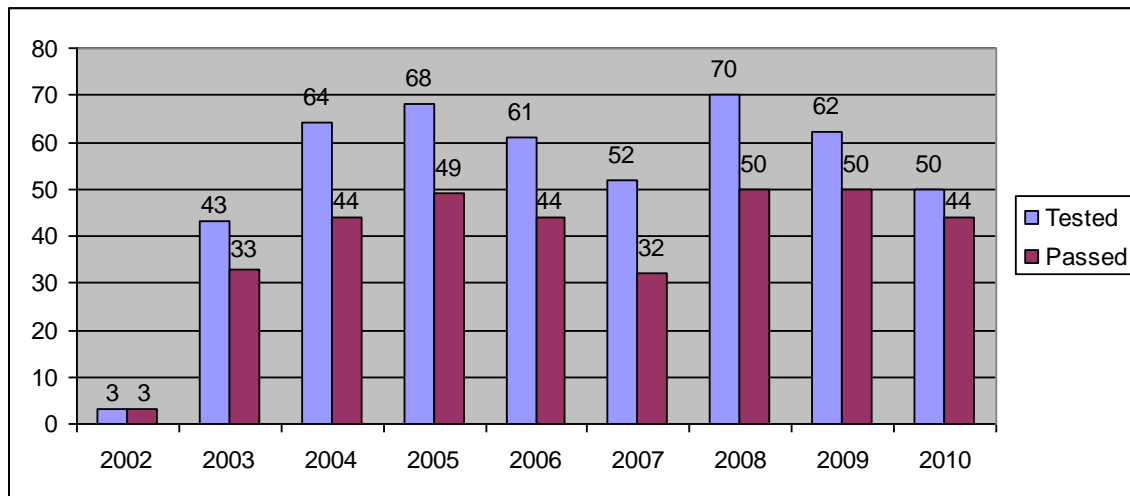
