2012 Hall of Fame Inductee Nathan Webb is a 2003 graduate of Brown County High School. He is the son of Larry and Donna Webb. Mr. Webb grew up in Nashville and attended Nashville Elementary. During his high school career, Mr. Webb earned nine varsity letters in soccer, cross country, and track and field. It is his outstanding track and field career that has earned him induction into the Brown County High School Athletic Hall of Fame.

Mr. Webb was a 2000 and 2001 IHSAA State Finalist as a member of the 3200m relay team. In 2002, he was again an IHSAA State Finalist in the 800m run. During the 2003 track and field season, Mr. Webb emerged as one of the top 800m runners in the state. During the 2003 IHSAA Track and Field State Finals, he finished in 9th place earning all-state honors and a place on the Indiana Track and Field All-Star Team.

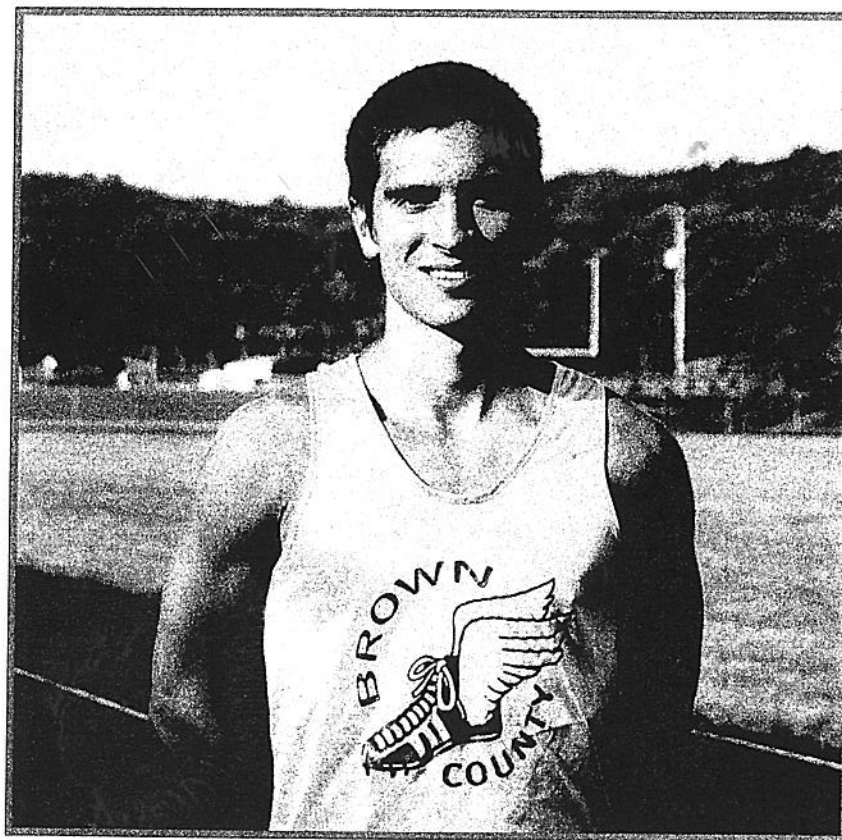
After graduation, Mr. Webb attended the University of Indianapolis where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing and participated on both the cross country and track and field teams.
